



CUT 2 IN FABRIC AND 2 IN LINING FABRIC

TIE-ON POCKET INSTRUCTIONS

This is a basic pattern for how to make a lined, tie-on pocket. If you want to decorate your pocket it is best to do it before you make the pocket up.

YOU WILL NEED

30 x 42cm x fabric for the pocket

30 x 42cm x light weight fabric to line the pocket

2 meters of bias binding

1. With right sides together sew the pocket pieces together, leaving a 1cm seam allowance.
2. Repeat with the pocket linings.
3. Trim the seam allowances to 5mm and turn the pocket so it is right side out and press. Leave the pocket lining as it is.
4. Place the lining inside the pocket, matching the pocket openings, tack in place around the opening.
5. Use 40cm of the bias binding to bind the pocket opening.
6. Tie the rest of the bias binding around your waist and work out where you'd like to place the pocket and mark with pins.
7. Make sure the bias binding is folded in half along it's length and insert the pocket top into the fold where you pinned. Tack in place.
8. Sew from one end of the bias to the other, reinforcing the ends and stitching close to the edge.
