
HOW TO MAKE A CONCERTINA SKETCH BOOK



COVER


Cut a piece of card the size of a postcard (A).

Using this as a guide, cut a piece of paper that is the same height but is wider and another piece that is the same width but is longer than the postcard (B + C).



Wrap paper B around your card, folding over the extra paper at the sides. Repeat with paper C on the other side of the postcard, wrapping the extra paper around the top and bottom.

Now tuck the flaps at the top and bottom of paper C in between the postcard and paper B.




You should end up with a postcard covered with the two sheets of paper with all the flaps tucked in. Repeat this process for the back cover.

INSIDE PAGES

Cut a long piece of paper the same height as the postcard and roughly 7 times the width (or 9 if you want more pages). You may have to glue a few strips together.



Fold the paper strip in half and, using the postcard as a guide, fold the paper into a zigzag with folds that are the same width as your postcard. You should get a section at either end that is narrower than the width of the postcard, these will be tucked into the front and back cover.



Slip the end flaps of the pages into the edges of the front and back covers.

Fill you new book with sketches! Remember that you can use both sides of the pages.
