
GIANT JAM SANDWICH FINGER PUPPET INSTRUCTIONS

YOU WILL NEED

scissors, pencil, a piece of cotton fabric the same size as the tea towel as a backing, a needle and thread (or a sewing machine)

INSTRUCTIONS

1 Using a pencil, draw a line roughly around each puppet 1cm away from the outline.



2 Lay the tea towel on top of the piece of cotton with the wrong sides together and pin.


3 Cut along the lines around the puppets.

4 Turn up and sew a 5mm hem along the bottom of each puppet and it's backing.

5 With right sides together sew the puppet to it's back, clip the seam allowances at the corners and curves, turn the right side out and press.

You could make the sandwich into a pouch to keep your puppets in.

1 Cut out the jam sandwich and then cut out two bits of the backing cotton using the sandwich as a pattern piece. The pieces need to overlap by about 4cm, as in the picture below.



2 Turn up and sew a 5mm hem along the straight edge of each sandwich back.

3 With right sides together pin and sew around 5mm away from the edge as pictured right.

4 Clip your corners and curves and turn right side out and press. Store your puppets inside.
