



A CARDBOARD HOW TO MAKE


- In place open end broad then bend each point of the frame opening and close edges.
- Dot some strong glue around your chosen picture in the centre of the larger rectangle, glue around it with strong, transparent glue.




- Same thin card like a cereal packet
- Straight edge
- Square paper (a lid from a cereal box)
- Coupled paper squares or squares
a differently box
- Scrap, old or new
- Some thin card like a cereal packet

YOU WILL NEED

- Using a scalpel, cut diagonally from the top corners to the bottom corners.
- Draw a rectangle measuring 3 x 4cm in the centre of the smaller piece of card.
- Using a scalpel, cut a small upside down 'V' shape in the area that will be covered by the smaller frame. Pierce the tip of it with a needle and thread some cotton through it. Knot it to create a loop to hang your frame from.
- Bend the triangles in the centre of the small piece of card back to make a frame.
- Snip a patterned edge around both pieces of card.



- At this point you could paint or decorate your frame.



- Place the clear plastic on the picture, followed by the small frame.
- Leave to dry.
